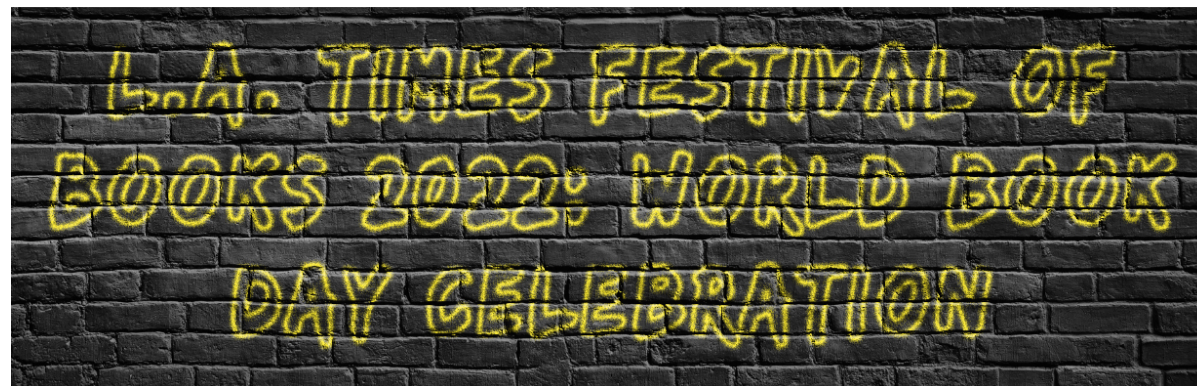


WHAT WE ARE SHARING TODAY
